## **Explanatory notes:**

- i. Article 89 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012, as it has effect in Great Britain, (referred to as GB BPR) and the Biocidal Products and Chemicals (Appointment of Authorities and Enforcement) Regulations 2013 (SI 2013 No. 1506) allows a biocidal product to remain on the market in Great Britain until it is authorised under GB BPR.
- ii. This approval is applicable/valid in Great Britain only (which means England, Scotland and Wales). This approval is not applicable/valid in Northern Ireland.
- iii. This certificate
  - a. revokes and replaces all previous terms and conditions of the approval;
  - b. extends the approval expiry date;
  - c. adds a GB suffix to the approval number (HSE No);

in Great Britain only (which means England, Scotland and Wales).

iv. The GB suffix has been added to reflect the product's approval status i.e., it can only be supplied and/or used in Great Britain. You must include this GB suffix on the product label at your next label reprint or by 31 December 2025 (whichever is the sooner).

Any stock already in use or in the supply chain does not require a new label.

Where the product also has approval in Northern Ireland under the Control of Pesticides Regulations (Northern Ireland) (NI COPR), it may be dual labelled. The product should be labelled in accordance with the conditions of the GB and NI approval. Any difference in approval conditions for each market area should be clear to the user.

- v. The power to amend or revoke this approval is exercisable at any time by HSE.
- vi. A failure to comply with the conditions of Approval and Consents may result in the revocation of the approval. Non-compliance with the law may result in enforcement action, including prosecution.
