Explanatory notes:

- Article 89 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012, as it has effect in North Ireland, (referred to as EU BPR) and the Biocidal Products and Chemicals (Appointment of Authorities and Enforcement) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2013 (SI 2013 No. 206) allows a biocidal product to remain on the market in Northern Ireland until it is authorised under EU BPR.
- ii. This approval is applicable/valid in Northern Ireland only. This approval is not applicable/valid in Great Britain (which means England, Scotland and Wales).
- iii. This certificate
 - a. revokes and replaces all previous terms and conditions of the approval;
 - b. extends the approval expiry date;
 - c. adds a NI suffix to the approval number (HSE No);

in Northern Ireland only.

iv. The NI suffix has been added to reflect the product's approval status i.e., it can only be supplied and/or used in Northern Ireland. You must include this NI suffix on the product label at your next label reprint or by 31 December 2025 (whichever is the sooner).

Any stock already in use or in the supply chain does not require a new label.

Where the product also has approval in Great Britain under the Control of Pesticides Regulations (GB COPR), it may be dual labelled. The product should be labelled in accordance with the conditions of the GB and NI approval. Any difference in approval conditions for each market area should be clear to the user.

- v. The power to amend or revoke this approval is exercisable at any time by HSE.
- vi. A failure to comply with the conditions of Approval and Consents may result in the revocation of the approval. Non-compliance with the law may result in enforcement action, including prosecution.
